

GOVERNMENT OF PUDUCHERRY - ELECTRICITY DEPARTMENT

MONTHLY REPORT OF IMPORTANT CASES FOR AUGUST 2016

1. 21 Nos of LT service connections existing in the Electricity Department, Main Office campus have been converted into a Single HT service connection on 29.07.2016 at Electricity Department, Puducherry.
2. Surveillance CCTVs were installed on 29.07.2016 in the the Main Office campus, Electricity Department, Puducherry at an estimate cost of Rs.2.70 lakhs.
3. The Thirubhuvanai Sub Division of Electricity Department, Puducherry held a camp at Kamaraj Nagar in Madagadipet on 3rd August 2016 and provided on the spot Domestic Service connections to 22 households. This effort of the department is first of its kind in the UT of Puducherry to check and stop illegal tapping of power. This programme will be extended to all areas of Puducherry.
4. Discussions had been held with the Director, Transmission and System Operation at Kerala State Electricity Board, Trivandrum on 05.08.2016 regarding bringing the power drawl of Mahe region under Regional Energy Accounting (REA) by which the Mahe region could avail the allocations from the Central Generating Stations(CGS).
5. 67 nos of new Computer Systems have been provided for replacement of Old Computer Systems in the Revenue Sections and Bill Collection Centres of UT of Puducherry.
6. Two Memorandum of Understandings (MOU) (1) under the Scheme UDAY- "Ujwal Discom Assurance Yojana" and (2) "24 x 7 Power for All" document and a tripartite agreement for "Integrated Power Development Scheme (IPDS)" were signed between the Government of Puducherry and the Government of India at New Delhi on 10.08.16.
7. The Thirubhuvanai Sub Division of Electricity Department, Puducherry held a second camp at Sellipet and Vambupet villages on 11.08.2016 and provided on the spot Domestic Service connections to 55 households thereby regularizing the unauthorized Service connections .This programme will be extended to all areas of Puducherry.
8. 21 nos of new Computer Systems have been provided for replacement of Old Computer Systems in the Revenue Sections and Bill Collection Centres of Outlying regions of UT of Puducherry.
9. A Roof Top Solar PV Plant of capacity 30 KW erected at Ecole de francais, Dumas street, Puducherry has been synchronized with the distribution network of the department on 12.08.16.
10. A 10MVA Power Transformer at Kalapet 110KV Substation has been brought back into service on 13.08.16 after Overhauling and testing.

11. Second batch of training was successfully conducted on training day of the month at Technical Training Centre for the Substation Operating Engineers on 18.08.2016.
12. Two line staff have been awarded commendation certificate by the Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor.
13. The issue taken up with the Ministry of Power on 21.07.16 on the meager allocation of Power to Puducherry from Neyveli New Thermal Power Station of 1000MW capacity has been considered fruitfully and the Ministry of Power has now allocated an additional 53MW of Power.
14. Approval of Kerala State Electricity Board Limited has been obtained for the drawl of Central Generating Station (CGS) Power at Mahe through Regional Energy Accounting (REA) of Southern Region.
15. On 24.08.16, following the heavy lightning and thunderstorm, the insulators shattered in the Thethampakkam – Sedharapet EHT lines and HT lines in many places, have been replaced immediately and power supply normalized.
16. A camp was conducted at Sorapet and Vinayagampet villages for providing on the spot Domestic Service connections to 68 nos of households thereby regularizing the unauthorized Service connections. This programme will be extended to all areas of Puducherry.
17. Induction Training imparted to the 8th batch of Construction Helpers in the Technical Training Centre , Marapalam.
